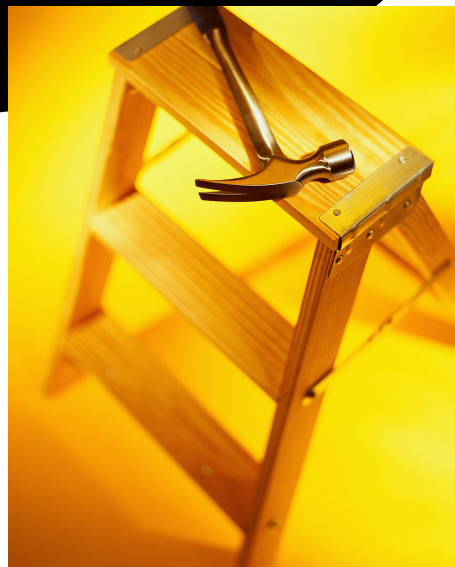

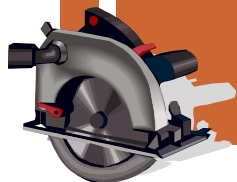

Hand tools:
